Privacy Policy

Monmouth Real Estate Investment Corporation ("Monmouth") is committed to your right to privacy and to keeping your personal information private.

This privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") pertains to information collected through this website and online services (collectively, the "Websites") hosted by Monmouth and its affiliates and subsidiaries (collectively referred to as "Monmouth") and by third parties on Monmouth's behalf. It does not pertain to information collected in other manners or offline.

How We Collect Your Information

Monmouth collects certain personal information about you whenever you send an email to Monmouth or complete one of our online forms on our Websites. The personal information you provide can identify you and your business, and includes such items as your name, your employer's name, email and U.S. mail address, and office and home telephone and fax numbers.

Personal Information

You may provide us with personally identifiable information ("Personal Information") when you use the Websites by explicitly providing this information to us. Automatic Data
